Phonics focus	This term we will be focusing on teaching Phase 5 Little Wandle Letters and Sounds.

Please ensure you are reading with your child at home every evening for a minimum of ten minutes. Please log all reading in your child's reading record. Activities to do at home: Practice letter sounds everyday Phonics games https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/picnic-on-pluto Share a book Practice reading and writing the "tricky words" Counting/recognising numbers Encourage independent writing Counting to and from 50. Adding and subtracting two single digit numbers Using household items to count and make groups such as pasta, socks etc. Playing dice games such as Ludo to help with number recognition. Homework will be given out every Friday. Sometimes documents will be added onto Google Classroom. To log into Google Classroom, use your child's unique username followed by @stjosephsgsuite.co.uk and their unique password. Year 1 class is referred to as 'St Patrick' class. Homework must be returned on Wednesdays. It is essential that you practise phonics with your children regularly to continue to develop their reading ability and understanding of language.
