Information for parents

Check for head lice



Regularly checking your child's hair will mean you
can spot head lice at the very first sign and treat
them effectively.

Treat the head lice

Treat head lice as soon as you see a live
one. Check all of the family and treat
anyone who has lice. And remember, if
you choose to use a medicated product,
only use it when you see live head lice. Do
not use a medicated product as a
preventative method, otherwise head lice
can build up a resistance.

Spread the word, not the lice

Head lice are extremely common - it's nothing to
be embarrassed about.

Do tell your child's school, child minder or
nursery so that they can alert other parents and
ask to get their children treated as soon as
possible.

If you don't, you run the risk of your now lice-
free child being re-infected by someone they
gave the lice to.
