LATENESS

Please make sure that your child arrives in school on time. The school day starts at **8.50am**. It is extremely important that children arrive on time ready to start the school day. When children arrive late this is extremely disruptive to the Class as lessons begin promptly.

EVERY MINUTE COUNTS

Being late also has a big effect on a child's learning and development

Lateness = Loss of learning over the academic year

5 minutes late each day - 3 days lost

10 minutes late each day - 6.5 days lost

15 minutes late each day - 10 days lost

20 minutes late each day - 13 days lost

30 minutes late each day - 19 days lost

The school recognises that there may be times when lateness is unavoidable. This may be due to traffic or severe weather conditions. This will show up in the register as a whole.

LATE BOOK

If your child is late for school it is very important that the late book is signed and also the time is logged as lessons are already in progress. This will also avoid an absent text being sent and/or any parent being worried unnecessarily.
