Year 5 trip to Pizza

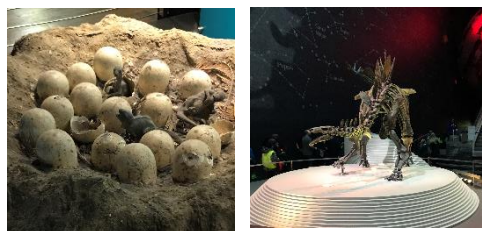
Express
