Year 5 trip to Ecology Park

This week Year 5 visited the Ecology Park! We looked at the life cycle of both plants and amphibians as well as pond dipping and creating scientific sketches of pond life. We were even allowed to hold a newt!



'Rufus Longbottom and the Space Rabbit', which will be coming to Greenwich Theatre for two performances on 1st June.

When Space Rabbit's planet is destroyed by a meteorite she escapes in the nick of time. A blast separates her from her family, sending her hurtling towards Earth. There she lands outside the Tandaria Care home, frightened and alone. Inside is Rufus Longbottom, an old gentleman itching for one last adventure. Guided by her magical paws, the unlikely pair go on a journey which takes them to the ends of the earth in the search for a family and a place to call home.

The show has developed from a literacy and music participation project we ran with KS2 children in Oxfordshire, Derbyshire and East London. We worked with the children on creating character and story through a physical and playful stimulus - and also looked at writing simple melodies and rhythms.

All the characters, environments, creatures and the major storyline have come from the participants' imaginations. The show is performed by 5 actors combining live multi-part harmony singing with on-stage sound design using 'Mi-Mu' gloves (like wearable loop-pedals) – all wrapped up in a traditional storytelling and puppetry show.
