Athletics

On Tuesday 5th December 17 pupils from Years 5 and 6 took part in an athletics competition at St Paul's Academy. The events included a mix of track and field events. We competed against 5 other schools on Tuesday but our times and distances were also being compared to 6 other schools who had competed the week before. We started the afternoon with the boys obstacle race followed by the girls obstacle race. Then we moved on to field events including standing long jump, standing triple jump, chest push, speed bounce, vertical jump and foam javelin. It was then back to the track events with the 1+1 lap relay. This saw two pupils run a lap each, passing the baton from the first runner to the second runner. The next track event was 2+2 lap relay. Two pupils had to run two laps each, again holding a baton. The 6 Lap Paarlauf was next. Two pupils had to run with the baton but could decide how many laps they both run. The objective was to get the baton round the track 6 times. The boys team decided to run 2 laps each then one lap each, passing the baton three times. The girls team run 3 laps each, passing the baton once. The final race was the 4x1 relay. Four pupils run each lap once passing the baton each time. All the pupils in the St Joseph's team performed extremely well. We are currently waiting on our final times and distances.
