Stop! Have You Washed Your Hands? Hand Washing Technique:



1. Scrub palm to palm.

3. Scrub in between and around your fingers.



4. Scrub your fingertips with the palm of your opposite hand.



5. Scrub each thumb clasped in your opposite hand.



6. Scrub your clasped fingertips in the palm of your hand and vice versa.

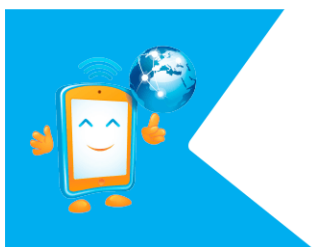
Together for a better internet

Safer Internet Day is a fantastic opportunity to have a conversation with children about using the internet safely, responsibly and positively.

Whether you are a parent, grandparent, foster carer, aunt, uncle or older sibling - we can all play a role in empowering children to enjoy their time online! - What do you like most about the internet and why? What's your favourite game/app/site?
- How does going online make you feel?
- How does the internet/technology make your life better?
- What could you do if being online is making you feel worse rather than better?
- What is different about talking online to someone compared to talking face to face? Is there anything that is the same?
- Can people say/do whatever they want online? Why/why not?

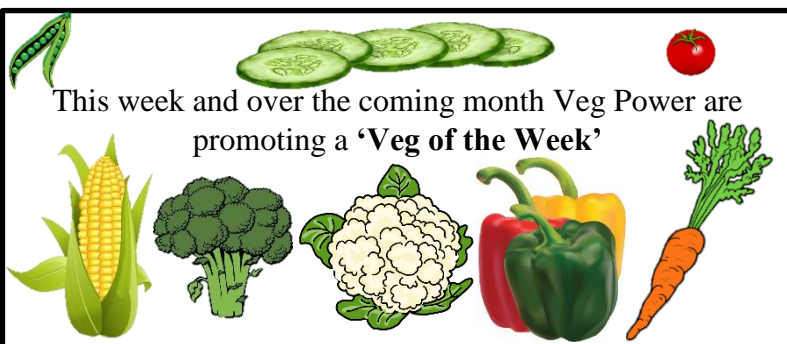
