When some were talking about the Temple, remarking how it was adorned with fine stonework and votive offerings, he said, 'All these things you are staring at now -- the time will come when not a single stone will be left on another; everything will be destroyed.' It also means you'll be able to see the results of your application much sooner. Online applicants will be able to log on to www.eadmissions.org.uk during the evening of 16 April 2020 to see the results of your application. Letters will be sent by first class post on 16 April 2020 informing those who applied by post.
