LATENESS

Please make sure that your child arrives in school on time. The school day starts at **8.50am**. It is extremely important that children arrive on time ready to start the school day. When children arrive late this is extremely disruptive to the Class as lessons begin promptly.

EVERY MINUTE COUNTS

Being late also has a big effect on a child's learning and development

Lateness = Loss of learning over the academic year

- 5 minutes late each day - 3 days lost**
- 10 minutes late each day - 6.5 days lost**
- 15 minutes late each day - 10 days lost**
- 20 minutes late each day - 13 days lost**
- 30 minutes late each day - 19 days lost**

The primary schools admissions booklet for 2020 is now available. You can download a copy at royalgreenwich.gov.uk/admissions

- Read the booklet carefully and visit as many schools as you can to find out what they have to offer
- Closing date for applications is **15 January 2020**

It's easier online

Applying for a primary school place online is quick and easy. The online application process is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week until the closing date. There is no risk of your application being lost or delayed in the post and you will receive confirmation that your application has been submitted successfully. It also means you'll be able to see the results of your application much sooner. Online applicants will be able to log on to www.eadmissions.org.uk during the evening of 16 April 2020 to see the results of your application. Letters will be sent by first class post on 16 April 2020 informing those who applied by post. To apply online visit www.eadmissions.org.uk and simply follow the instructions.
