

# Behaviour policy & practice in response to COVID-19

## Appendix to Relationships and Positive Behaviour Policy 2020

### St Joseph's Catholic Primary School

In response to Covid 19 and the change in circumstance:

- Staff to be trained on new appendix to behaviour code
- Changes to the behaviour code will be shared with children and parents:
  - No coughing or sneezing over others
  - No leaving your bubble without an adult.
  - No taking of other resources without permission
  - Follow guidance on hygiene
  - Follow the system of travel within and around the school
  
- The behaviour system will operate with 3 warnings within the classroom setting.
- The children will not be able to sit on time out due to space.
- The children will not be able to go to another class due to the mixing of bubbles
- SLT will be radioed and come to speak to the child and support in class until behaviour has settled.

- Good hygiene followed by SLT before and after entering the room.
- If the behaviour continues then SLT will remove the child from the room and contact the parents to collect the child.
- If supportive handling is needed then PPE shall be worn to protect the child and staff.
- PPE will include, gloves and mask. If needed goggles can be worn and an apron if the child is spitting or biting.
- Risk assessment will be undertaken to see if the child can return to school on a phased return in the first instance or if safer for themselves and others if they remain at home.
