Geography



Barra, Outer Hebrides

Typical of the beaches on the west coast of the Outer Hebrides – deserted white sand between rocky promontories.



Isle of Coll, Inner Hebrides

Sand has been blown inland and trapped between rocky headlands to form extensive dunes. Marram grass has grown on the dunes, stabilising them against erosion.



Watersay, Outer Hebrides

Watersay is an island at the southern end of the Outer Hebrides, now joined to Barra by a 250m causeway opened in 1991. Here houses are spread out along the rocky, seaweedy coastline, but elsewhere on the island there are long, sweeping, white sandy beaches.



Sidmouth, Devon

Red cliffs and pebble beach to the west of Sidmouth.



Porthchapel bay, Cornwall


Just east of Land's End on the south coast of Cornwall, Porthchapel Bay is a small, sheltered, sandy beach, trapped between high granite cliffs. It is reached by walking along a narrow path near the cliff edge.




St. Just, Cornwall

Granite cliffs and rocky 'beach' on the west coast of Cornwall near St. Just, being battered by a rough sea. The hard granite rock resists erosion, but the 'beach' is smoothed and rounded by boulders being rolled around on it by the sea.


