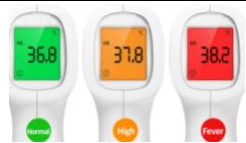

A gentle reminder to please not include fizzy drinks, sweets and chocolate bars in your children's packed lunches.

Illness & Absence



If a child has one or more of the main coronavirus symptoms below, they must stay at home and be tested to see if they have COVID-19.

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature (37.8 degrees or above)
- a loss of, or change in their normal sense of taste or smell

If your child develops one or more of the main symptoms described above, only they should be tested. There is no need for anyone else in the household to be tested, unless they have symptoms.

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19, however mild, self-isolate for at least 10 days from when their symptoms started.

After 10 days, if they still have a temperature you should continue to self-isolate and seek medical advice. They do not need to self-isolate after 10 days if they only have a cough or loss of sense of smell or taste, as these symptoms can last for several weeks after the infection has gone.

We are a Nut Free School

Some of our staff, students and visitors have a severe allergic reaction to nuts and peanuts. Severe allergic reactions result in anaphylaxis and can be fatal. Because of this we are a Nut Free School and ask that children do not bring peanuts, nuts and products containing either into
