- 78% of students achieved a grade 4 or better and 74% of students achieved a grade 3 or better in Mathematics
- 80% of students achieved a grade 4 or above in both English and Mathematics
- 61% of students achieved a grade 3 or above in both English and Mathematics
- English Baccalaureate Average Point Score has increased to 5.44
- Attendance % score has increased to 91.13
