This week the whole school achieved **96.7%** attendance.

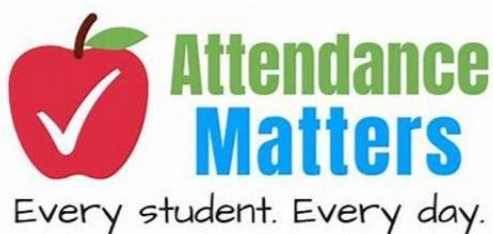
Keeping attendance above 95% allows the pupils to achieve their potential.

Lateness

Please make sure that your child arrives in school on time. It is extremely important that children arrive on time ready to start the school day. When children arrive late this is extremely disruptive to the Class as lessons begin promptly.

EVERY MINUTE COUNTS

Being late also has a big effect on a child's learning and development.

Lateness = Loss of learning over the academic year

5 minutes late each day – 3 days lost

10 minutes late each day – 6.5 days lost

15 minutes late each day – 10 days lost

20 minutes late each day – 13 days lost

30 minutes late each day – 19 days lost
