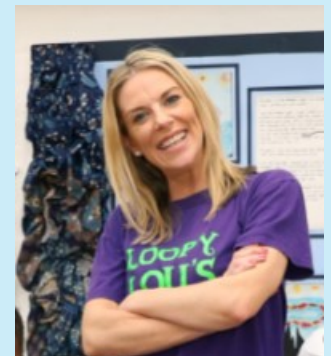

# ST JOSEPH'S GOOGLE MEET LIVE SESSIONS

## HOW TO JOIN THE GOOGLE MEET LIVE SESSIONS

- To attend these sessions your child will need to click on the link in their Google Classroom stream. You can also access the '**Loopy Lou Virtual classes**'. They will have already been invited to the Google classroom for their year group.
- The camera icon and meeting code will appear at the top of the Google Classroom, 5 minutes before the session.
- If you are joining a session, it is important you log on just before the start time and are not late.
- To access Google Meet you will need to have logged in via your child's Google Classroom login/e-mail address. If you are trying to access via a smartphone or tablet, it is advisable that you download the Google Meet app.
- We ask that pupils only join the sessions for their year groups. Of course siblings (especially older) can be in the same room or even be on camera but they would be encouraging their sibling rather than just participating themselves.
- We ask that no photos or videos are taken of any of the sessions.
- You can change the layout of the session so you can just see the teacher by clicking on the three dots, clicking change layout and clicking spotlight.
- **We ask that ALL children put their mic on MUTE as soon as they enter the session and only unmute if asked to do so. If you do not MUTE when you enter, this may mean that you will not be able to attend future sessions**
